TODAY'S SUMMARY

The last day of July is giving us some of the hottest temperatures of the summer. DFW, Austin and San Antonio will all be well over 100 degrees while Houston is forecasted to have a high of 102.

The ERCOT demand at 7:55 AM this morning was 54,854 MW, about 1,300 MW behind the established peak load day print at the same time. Today's profile should slowly catch up to the peak day print later today. Since today is the last day a potential July peak could be set we should expect to see a lot of curtailments. These curtailments may keep today's peak below the established peak set on the 18th.

Today is currently a **HIGH** potential 4CP day. If a 4CP event is called today the curtailment window will be from 3:30 - 6:00 PM.
